TEACHERS AND STUDENTS TOGETHER IN CONCERT - CCMTA

Purpose:

To provide a performance opportunity for teachers of all instruments and their students to perform together in concert. To help prepare students (both adult and children) for a public performance by performing in an ensemble with their teacher. This event also provides the opportunity for the teacher to perform solo works as well.

Eligibility:

- 1. No SA membership required.
- 2. No theory test requirement.
- 3. Students must be studying with a CCMTA teacher at the time of the event.
- 4. Teachers may sign up for 2 performing slots which may include: 2 Teacher Solos, 2 Teacher in Ensemble with Students or a combination of both Solo and Ensemble.

Criteria:

- 1. Students perform an ensemble piece with their teacher. Students do not perform solo.
- 2. Performers may use music.
- 3. Selections may be from a church hymnal, published arrangements, a students' own arrangement/composition, or standard repertoire.
- 4. If a sound track is part of the ensemble, please be sure to bring your own audio equipment.

Total performance time for each selection must not exceed 5 minutes.

Recital Set Up:

Students and teachers are listed in a formal program and perform as in a normal recital. The event will usually take place in a retirement center, and friends and family are welcomed and encouraged to attend.

Registration:

By the deadline listed in the Yearbook, complete and submit to the Recital Chairman:

 Teachers and Students Together in Concert On-line Registration (CCMTA.org→Members→Forms → Teachers and Students Together In Concert form).

2. Specific Instructions for filling out the On-line Registration Form:

- A. If you have several students to register, and want to make the registration process as easy as possible -- do the following:
 - Complete the entire form the first time including your email, CCMTA teacher number, and last name. If you have a last name that is shared by another member, please *always* indicate your 1st initial with the last name. (All other teachers need only to put their last name).
 - 2. For all other student registrations, teachers need to only fill out their CCMTA number and last name (1st initial, if needed). No need to keep filling out the email address.
- B. If you make an error, just re-enroll the student again and contact the Chair which entry to delete. You cannot delete or change an entry yourself once you submit it.

- 3. If you wish to have a record of your student registrations: Once you are finished enrolling students, please send an email to the Chair indicating you would like a spreadsheet. The Chair will then within 24 hours send you a spread sheet of your registration information. It is the teacher's responsibility to ask for this because it is not apparent on the big spreadsheet who has and has not received a record of their registrations. Please be patient with the Chair, as this is a big job.
- 5. There is no charge for this event.

Coda:
